Proclamation

WHEREAS, beginning in 1926, the Caruso Family built one of the largest privately held corporations in Central Florida known as Southern Fruit Distributors; and

WHEREAS, in 1986, the Carusos closed their citrus plant and began concentrating on commercial real estate and land development by creating Pineloch Management Corporation; and

WHEREAS, over the past 20 years, Pineloch Management has built a solid foundation in the commercial leasing field; and

WHEREAS, the Caruso family has established a legacy of community service to benefit the region, Orange County, and the City of Orlando; and

WHEREAS, Pineloch Management has been recognized by the Building Owners and Managers Association with the 2001-02 and 2002-03 TOBY (The Office of the Year) Award in the Industrial Office Park Category; the National Associations of Industrial and Office Parks 2001 NAIOP Award of Excellence for Large Industrial Development; and has received special recognition from the Trust for Public Lands Florida Trail Association; and

WHEREAS, the Orange County Board of County Commissioners wishes to recognize the Caruso Family and Pineloch Management Corporation as valued and involved corporate citizens;
